

The Gerritsen Collection: Women's History Online, 1543-1945 is the greatest single source for the study of international women's history and the feminist movement.

The Gerritsen Collection

The Gerritsen Collection is a 2,000,000 page international digital library that spans four centuries and documents the lives and experiences of women in public and private arenas. This collection was begun in the late 19th century by Aletta H. Jacobs (1854-1929), a leading feminist and the Netherlands' first woman doctor, and her husband C.V. Gerritsen. The Gerritsen Collection allows scholars to trace the evolution of feminism within a single country, as well as the impact of one country's movement on those of the others.

- More than 4,700 publications from continental Europe, the U.S., the United Kingdom, Canada, and New Zealand, dating from 1543-1945, including:
 - **Periodical Series:** 25 percent of the collection, 265 titles spanning complete runs from 1860 through 1900.
 - **Monograph Language Series:** 4,470 monographs and pamphlets comprise 75 percent of the collection.
- English- more than 2,000 titles are the greatest source for tracking suffragism and feminism in the English-speaking world.
- German- 929 titles document the history of an organized movement, as well as women and socialism, Jewish women's status, and Swiss feminism.
- French- 734 titles cover women in military, law, and reforms in women's legal, civil, and economic rights, as well as women's influence on French literature from Gaelic times through World War II.
- Other languages- 12 languages and 472 titles.

Indexing for The Gerritsen Collection

The Gerritsen Collection uses Library of Congress subject headings.

The ASCII text is searchable by keyword and Boolean operators, and records are linked to the corresponding page images, downloadable in PDF format.

The Gerritsen Collection has 10 searchable fields.
