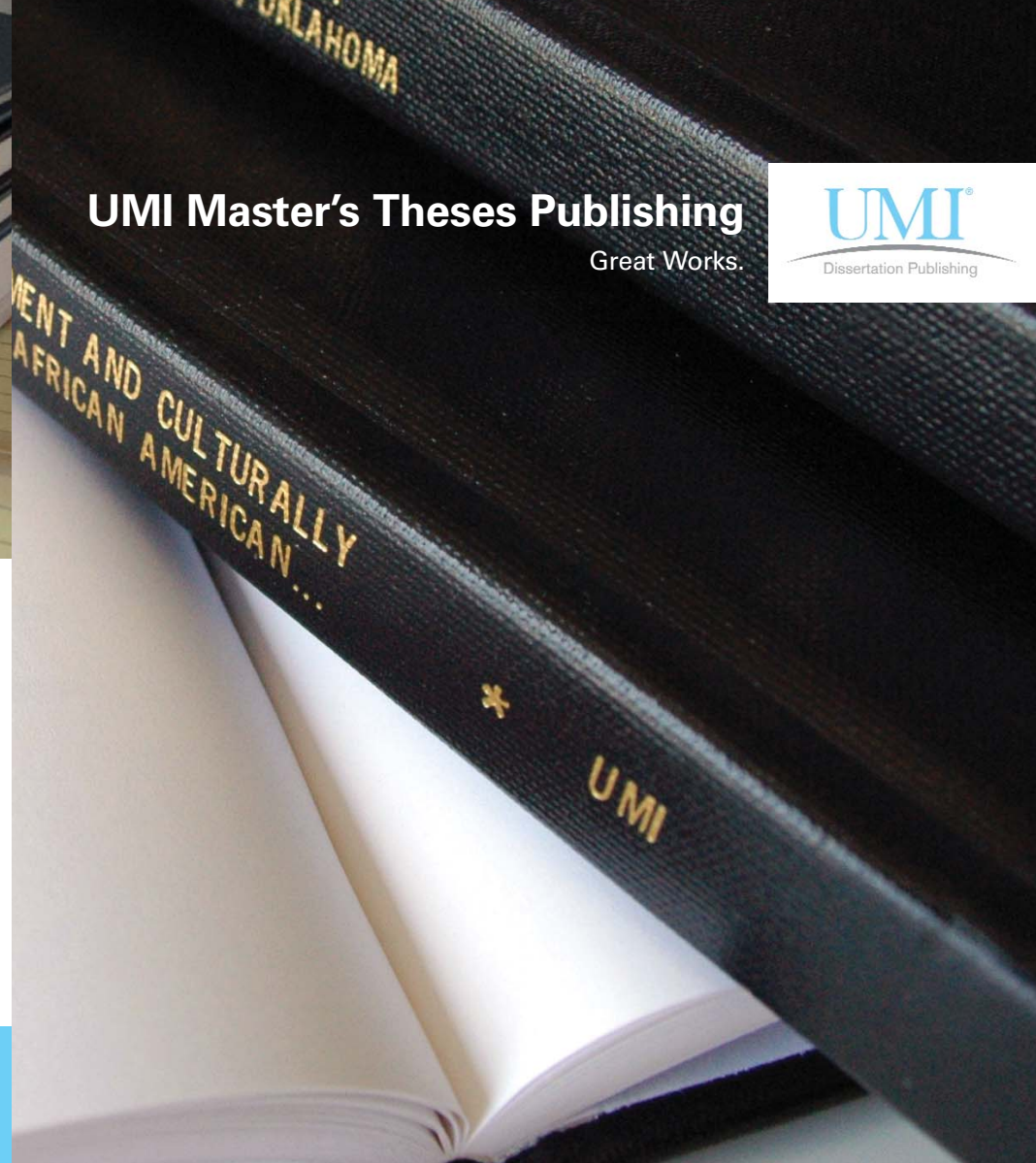

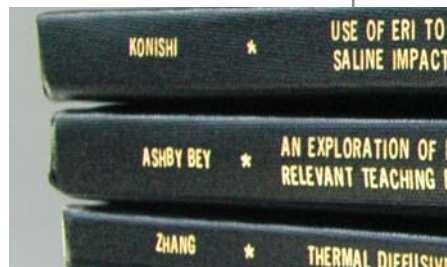
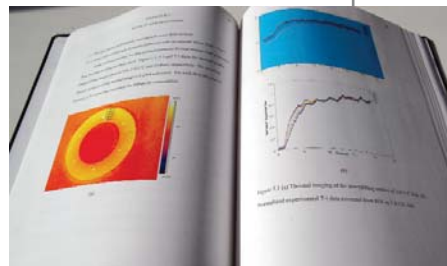

- ▶ Paper stock is 32-lb. weight. In addition to the acid-free archival grade, this photographic quality stock is a brighter white that is more opaque for best ink contrast and better readability.
- ▶ Any color graphics included in the digital copy of the thesis received by UMI can now be reproduced in color. Photographs, charts, and other illustrations are printed as faithfully as they were provided electronically. Conforming to norms set by the Library Binding Institute for Class A Library Binding, our author copies feature hand-made thread sewn bindings and generous margins for opening flat while reading.
- ▶ The hardbound copies are 8-1/2" x 11" with elegant black covers made from 2.5mm-thick board covered in washable library buckram. Titles are embossed in gold foil on the spine. It's the manufacturing quality that evokes rare-book publishing, and a volume to last a lifetime.
