Offering the full text of many journals from the Hispanic American Periodicals Index (HAPI), Prisma features hard-to-secure Spanish-language content that is vitally needed for research in the social sciences and humanities. ■ Growing academic interest in the Hispanic and Latin American traditions coupled with changing demographics has led libraries to re-evaluate the scope of their related holdings. Prisma can immediately fill a critical need for Spanish-language journal content by providing digital access to the full text of many titles that are not readily available in other

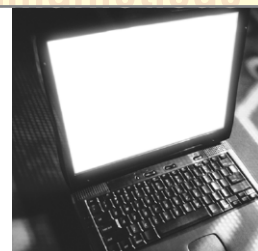
formats. Many of the journals in Prisma are published only in hardcopy or outside the U.S. For some, an e-journal may be available but offers no archive or searching. ■ With Prisma, users get total, searchable online access to these essential, hard-to-find journals. Select titles include:

HAPI Indexing for Better Searching From analyses of current political, economic, and social issues to unique coverage of Latin American arts and letters, HAPI contains complete bibliographic citations to articles, book reviews, documents, original literary works, and other materials appearing in more than 500 key social science and humanities journals published throughout the world. ■ If your library currently subscribes to HAPI, you'll be pleased to know that Prisma is fully integrated with this leading index. HAPI subscribers can use the HAPI subject index within Prisma when searching Prisma's full-text journals. ■ Prisma gives you English, Spanish, and Portuguese interface options. Users can search by keyword, article title,

author, journal title, subject (HAPI subscribers only), publication, language, country of publication, publication date, and ISSN. Searches can be limited to full text, peer reviewed, or articles about U.S. Hispanics only. Results can be sorted to identify the most recent, oldest, or most relevant. Results can also be displayed by journal title, and hit-term highlighting in search results makes it easy to find your search terms in context. ■ Prisma users will also enjoy all the standard features and functionality that you expect to see in Chadwyck-Healey™ databases:
